APPLICATION METHOD:

FIBREFLEX should be applied liberally to attain desired Dry Film Thickness. Floor wall joints, drains and other areas to be compliant with Standards

WARRANTY:

The manufacturer warrants that the product **FIBREFLEX** will be free from defects in material and manufacture from the time of application and for a period of seven(7) years thereafter. This warranty is effective only on condition that the **FIBREFLEX** system was applied in strict conformance with the manufacturers printed application instructions in effect at the time.
